CE Marking and Checking Policy

This Policy has been drafted with reference to National Highways Sector Scheme 16 (NHSS 16) and our processes and activities are aligned and reviewed against this Scheme.

We ensure all products and materials we obtain as part of our works are from a sustainable source and carry a CE mark. This is achieved by both visual checks carried out and documentation obtained by reputable suppliers on the source and origin for all products we attain.

CE marking is a certification mark that indicates conformity with health, safety, and environmental protection standards for products sold within the European Economic Area (EEA).

The CE marking is also found on products sold outside the EEA that are manufactured in, or designed to be sold in, the EEA. This makes the CE marking recognizable worldwide even to people who are not familiar with the European Economic Area. It is in that sense similar to the FCC Declaration of Conformity used on certain electronic devices sold in the United States.

The CE marking is the manufacturer's declaration that the product meets the requirements of the applicable EC directives.[2]

The mark consists of the CE logo and, if applicable, the four digit identification number of the Notified Body involved in the conformity assessment procedure.
